IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Date of State Convention.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 4, § 16, amended. The 1st sentence of section 16 of chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~'Not less than 60 nor more than 90 days before~~ **Not more than 90 days before**
or not more than 30 days after the 3rd Monday in June of each year in which a biennial state election is to be held, each political party shall hold a state convention with such basis of representation and at such time and place and with such requisites as to call and notice therefor as the state committee of each such political party may determine.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 4, § 16, amended. The 5th sentence of section 16 of chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 349 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~'The chairman of the state committee may be chosen from within or without the membership of the state committee and shall be chosen as soon as possible after the 15th day of May next following the state convention.'~~
