IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Renewals of Malt Beverage Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 24-A, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 24-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 24-A. Renewal licenses. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, renewal of all malt liquor licenses shall be issued by the Liquor Commission unless the municipal officers of the municipality wherein the premises are located, or in case of unincorporated places, the county commissioners of the county wherein such unincorporated place is located, object in writing to the Liquor Commission by December 1st preceding the year for which the renewal license is requested.'
