RESOLVE, Providing for a Vocational Technical Institute in Eastern Maine.

Vocational Technical Institute; appropriation for. Resolved: The Department of Education be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to establish, maintain and operate a State Vocational Education Institute in such location in Eastern Maine as it deems best, to promote specialized training for those who give evidence of special aptitude or need and who desire specialized training designed specifically to train for service in trade, industry or commerce; and be it further

Resolved: That the Department of Education be, and hereby is, authorized and empowered to receive such gifts and donations, either from public or private sources as may be offered unconditionally; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$490,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 and \$110,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959 to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There is a great need for vocational education in Eastern Maine, and the purpose of this resolve is to provide assistance to those in Eastern Maine who need training for service in trade, industry and commerce.
