STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Clerk Hire of County Officers in Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes which relates to clerk hire in Androscoggin county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$7,670 \$8,440; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$7,820 \$2,000; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$3,740; for clerks in the office of sheriff, \$600 \$660; for clerk hire in the office of county treasurer and county commissioners, \$7,560 \$1,720.'
