COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 951, L. D. 1352, Bill, "An Act  
Revising Law Relating to Pharmacists."

Amend said Bill by striking out in "Sec. 5" all of the 8th and  
9th lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'he had been ~~an-apprentice-or-employed-in-an-apothecary-store-where~~  
~~physicians'-prescriptions-are-compounded-at-least-4-years,-or-has~~  
graduated'

Further amend said Bill in "Sec. 11" by indicating the striking  
out of the word "rubbing" in the 11th line by drawing a line through  
said word as follows '~~rubbing~~'
