STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Medical Examiners for View and Autopsy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 252, amended. The 1st sentence of section 252 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every medical examiner shall render an account of the expense of each case, including his fees, to the county attorney, who shall audit and approve the same before it is submitted to the county commissioners for their approval, and the fees allowed the medical examiner shall not exceed the following viz: For a view and inquiry without an autopsy, \$15; for a view and autopsy, \$50 \$100; for an inquest, \$10 per day for the time actually spent in holding such inquest and for all necessary travel at the rate of 10c per mile.'
