# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Duties of Animal Husbandry Specialist.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 100, § 10, amended.** The 2nd sentence of the 6th paragraph of section 10 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The representatives of the Department of Agriculture in charge of animal husbandry shall be known as the Animal Husbandry Specialist and the Assistant Animal Husbandry Specialist, and who shall devote their time to the carrying carry out of the provisions of the dog licensing laws and the adjustment of claims for damages to livestock and poultry by dogs and wild animals, and to the promotion of animal husbandry within the State.'
