STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Duties of Animal Husbandry Specialist.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 100, § 10, amended. The 2nd sentence of the 6th paragraph of section 10 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The representatives of the Department of Agriculture in charge of animal husbandry shall be known as the Animal Husbandry Specialist and the Assistant Animal Husbandry Specialist, ~~and who shall devote their time to the carrying~~ **carry** out ~~of~~ the provisions of the dog licensing laws and the adjustment of claims for damages to livestock ~~and poultry~~ by dogs and wild animals, and to the promotion of animal husbandry within the State.'
