AN ACT Establishing the St. Joseph Game Preserve, Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 149, amended. Section 149 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by inserting in alphabetical order the following:

'St. Joseph Game Preserve. Frye's Island in the town of Raymond, Cumberland county, and commencing at the intake on route #35; thence northerly along route #35 to town road; thence along the town road to White's bridge in town of Standish; thence southerly along Sebago Lake to the point of beginning.'
