STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Permitting the Issuance of Temporary Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 2-A, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 2-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. Temporary licenses. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2, the Liquor Commission may issue 90-day temporary liquor licenses to any applicant therefor. Such licenses must be otherwise authorized by, and the applicant must be qualified under, the provisions of this chapter. No more than 2 such 90-day temporary licenses shall be issued annually to any one applicant.'
