COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 466, L. D. 1379, Bill, "An Act Relating to Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 7th line the underlined word "six" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '9'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 22nd line the underlined figure "3" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '2'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the follow-ing new sentence:

'In the event that a municipality which shall have approved flouridation shall vote to discontinue such fluoridation and the public utility or agency serving such municipality has constructed or installed fluoridation facilities, such public utility or agency shall be entitled to amortize the remaining cost of its investment in such facilities, and to allocate the cost of such amortization among its customers, over such period of time as shall be approved by the Public Utilities Commission.'
