# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Membership in State Board of Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 2, amended. The 1st and 2nd sentences of section 2 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes are hereby amended to read as follows:

The Board, as heretofore created by previous enactment, shall consist of 10 members who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council. The Governor with the advice and consent of the Council shall appoint 5 members representing each of the following groups and organizations which shall, in accordance with their particular by laws or policies, submit one name, and if necessary, successive names, to the Governor: one by the presidents of the liberal arts and teachers' colleges of the State, the person named not to be an active college president; one by the Maine Municipal Association, the person named not to be the active president of the Association; one by the Maine Superintendents' Association, the person named not to be the active president of the organization; one by the Maine Teachers' Association, the person named not to be the president of the association; the other 5 members shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council.'
