AN ACT Relating to the Primary Law in the City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1933, c. 71, § 2, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 2 of chapter 71 of the private and special laws of 1933, as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 83 of the private and special laws of 1941, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Only those voters enrolled as qualified to vote in such caucuses as hereinafter provided shall participate therein; all nominations by petitions or as provided for under section ~~3~~ 52 of chapter ~~7~~ 4 of the Revised Statutes of 1954 shall be voted upon at the next municipal election, and the caucus for such candidates by petition or by said nomination papers shall be held in the several wards of the city on the 2nd Monday of December, in each year, on which day the polls will be opened at ~~3~~ 1 o'clock in the afternoon and continue open to 8 o'clock in the evening, when they shall close.'
