AN ACT Relating to Restoration to Service on Part-Time Basis Under State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof 2 new paragraphs, as follows:

‘Anything to the contrary notwithstanding if any recipient of benefits be restored to service on a part-time or consulting basis, not to exceed 60% of annual full-time rating in the capacity served, he shall be entitled to his retirement allowance in addition to his compensation as long as such total compensation does not exceed 150% of the average final compensation used in determining his retirement allowance.

No such person shall be restored to service without the approval of the Governor and Council.’
