RESOLVE, Relating to Investigating Special Resolve Pensions.

Special resolve pensions; investigated. Resolved: That the Legislature through its Joint Committee on Retirements and Pensions investigate all special resolve pensions for the purpose of determining which should be continued, and report to this Legislature whatever acts and resolves it deems necessary.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time there are some 259 active special resolve pensions. These should all be investigated and redetermined by the Legislature.
