**AN ACT Relating to Proration of Registration Fees of Motor Buses in
Interstate Commerce.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ I, ¶ C, sub-¶ 2, amended. Subparagraph 2 of paragraph C of subsection I of section 16 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 1st sentence a new sentence to read as follows :

'Except that notwithstanding any other provisions in this section, and owner or operator of interstate motor buses used for the transportation of passengers for hire, operating a fleet of 2 or more motor buses under the the authority of the Interstate Commerce Commission and the Public Utilities Commission, shall register and pay registration fees, as scheduled in this section, for that number of motor buses of the owner or operator as the proportion which the mileage of all such motor buses of the owner or operator, operated in this State bears to the total mileage of all such motor buses of the owner or operator operated both within and without the State in accordance with the owner or operator or his or its predecessor's operation of the preceding year, and the Secretary of State is authorized to promulgate such rules and regulations as may be necessary to effectuate such apportionment.'
