HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 986, L. D. 1410, Bill, "An Act Increasing Sales Tax with Exemptions on Water, Fuel and Electricity for Domestic Use."

Amend said Bill by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 'Sec. 5.' to read as follows:

"Sec. 5. R. S., c. 17, §10, sub-§VII-A, additional. Section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapters 405 and 477 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered VII-A, to read as follows:

'VII-A. Water. Water purchased by any individual for use exclusively in his home and upon the land surrounding the same; provided said water shall not be exempt if, without separate metering or separate intake, the premises supplied with water shall be used not only for the home of the purchaser but also for a store, place of business, farm or any other purpose.'"
