SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 986, L. D. 1410, Bill, "An Act
Increasing Sales Tax with Exemptions on Water, Fuel and
Electricity for Domestic Uses."

Amend said Bill by adding thereto a new section following "Sec.
5" to read as follows:

"Sec. 5-A. R. S., c. 17, §10, sub-§VII, amended. Subsection
VII of section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes is hereby
amended to read as follows:

'VII. Seed, feed, fertilizer and bait. Sales of seed, feed
, hormones, and fertilizer , pesticides, insecticides, fungicides,
weed killers, defoliants, litter, and medicines used in agricultural
production and sales of bait to commercial fishermen.'"
