AN ACT Prohibiting Fishing by Trawlers in Sheepscot Bay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 29-A, additional. Chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 29-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 29-A. Use of drags in Sheepscot bay. It shall be unlawful to use beam or other trawls in taking all fish in all the waters of Sheepscot bay, from the south end of Seguin Island easterly to Pumpkin Island.'
