SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1006, L. D. 1432, Bill, "An Act Relating to Appointment of Deputy Commissioner for Penal Institutions and One for Psychiatric Institutions."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'An Act Relating to Appointment of Deputy Commissioner of Institutional Service.'

Further amend said Bill in "Sec. 1" by striking out the underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

"'The Commissioner shall appoint, subject to the provisions of the Personnel Law, a Deputy Commissioner and shall assign to him such duties as are necessary to carry out the provisions of this chapter. In the event of vacancy in the office of the Commissioner, or during his absence or disability, the Deputy Commissioner shall perform the same duties and have the same powers as prescribed by law for the Commissioner.'"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of "Sec. 2" thereof.

Further amend said Bill in "Sec. 3", in the 2nd and 3rd lines, by striking out the figure "\$30,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$11,000'.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering "Sec. 3" to be 'Sec. 2'.
