**RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Elizabeth Francoeur of Lewiston.**

**Elizabeth Francoeur; state pension. Resolved.** That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Elizabeth Francoeur, of Lewiston, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

Elizabeth Francoeur is 89 years of age and has been an invalid for 20 years. She now lives with her daughter. Her children do not feel that they are financially able to support her. Mrs. Francoeur has no means of support.
