STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Publication of Legal Notices in Foreign Language Newspapers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 1, § 34, amended. Section 34 of chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 34. Publication of legal notices and advertising. To be qualified as a medium for the publication of legal notices, legal advertising and other matter required by law to be published in a newspaper, a newspaper, unless otherwise ordered by the court in the proceedings, must be published and printed in whole or in part in this State or, where the law so requires, in whole or in part in the county where the notice is required to be published; must be printed in the English language; and must be entered as second class postal matter in the United States mails at the post office in the place of such printing and publication-provided that nothing. Such legal notices and advertising may be published in a foreign language newspaper, provided such legal notices and advertising in said newspaper are published in the English language. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to alter or in any way affect the existing law governing the foreclosure of real estate mortgages, chattel mortgages or any conditional sales contract, by publication.'
