RESOLVE, Providing Additional Funds for the Maine State Office Building.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves passed by the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies ; and

Whereas, it now appears that funds heretofore appropriated are not sufficient to complete the constructing and equipping of the State Office Building in Augusta and the remodeling of the State House offices and the Highway-Health Building ; and

Whereas, for the proper functioning of State Government it is vitally necessary that the constructing and equipping of the State Office Building in Augusta and the remodeling of the State House offices and the Highway-Health Building be completed as soon as possible ; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety ; now therefore, be it

Additional appropriation for new office building. Resolved: That the sum of \$295,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the purpose of completing the constructing and equipping of the State Office Building in Augusta and the remodeling of the State House offices and the Highway-Health Building.

The appropriation provided by the provisions of this resolve shall not lapse,

but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Funds already appropriated for the constructing and equipping of the State Office Building in Augusta and for remodelling of the State House offices and the Highway-Health Building have proved insufficient. This resolve is to provide needed additional funds so that the projects may be completed.
