RESOLVE, in Favor of Eastern Maine General Hospital.

Eastern Maine General Hospital; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$2,135.21 to be paid to Eastern Maine General Hospital, to reimburse it for hospitalization of Freeland Barker.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Freeland Barker received a compound fracture of the leg in 1955. He was taken to the Milliken Memorial Hospital in Island Falls. His leg did not heal and he was taken to the Eastern Maine General Hospital in Bangor. He is a resident of the town of Crystal, but the town is unable to pay for his hospitalization and is asking the State to pay it.

Mr. Barker had never had town help previous to this accident and the town feels that he should have been taken care of under the Hospital Aid Program.
