**RESOLVE, in Favor of Donald LaPierre of Westbrook.**

**Donald LaPierre; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$177 to be paid to Donald LaPierre, of Westbrook, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State for damage to his car which was taken by an escapee from the Reformatory for Men at South Windham.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

Mr. LaPierre's car was stolen by an escapee from the Reformatory for Men at South Windham. The car was apprehended at Bath after a wild chase by police starting in Yarmouth and winding up in Bath at the railroad when he failed to make a turn and piled up on railroad guard rails. Mr. LaPierre is asking for \$177 to pay for damages to his car.
