STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Houlton for Pauper Supplies.

Town of Houlton; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$50 to be paid to the town of Houlton to reimburse it for aid given to Thomas McIntosh.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. McIntosh was living in the town of Houlton prior to his death. His pauper settlement was in Brookton, Maine. The proper notification was sent to Brookton. A year passed and the claim had not been paid and upon investigation it was found that the State looked out for the Brookton paupers. The State should reimburse the town of Houlton for the amount of \$50 for aid given to Mr. McIntosh.
