# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Walks and Handrails on Railroad Bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 46, § 75-A, additional. Chapter 46 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 75-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 75-A. Walks and handrails on railroad bridges. The Public Utilities Commission shall have the right, upon complaint and after hearing, to require any common carrier by railroad to equip their bridges and trestles with suitable walks and handrails if after such hearing the Public Utilities Commission finds that such walks and handrails are necessary for the safety of the public or railroad employees.'
