IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Tenure of Office of Members of Highway Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 23, § 3, amended. The 5th sentence of section 3 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The other members of the Commission shall receive \$4,000 per year and shall be appointed **one for a term of 2 years and one** for a term of 3 years and any vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 23, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new sentence following the 5th sentence to read as follows:

'Thereafter the members of the Commission, other than the Chairman, shall be appointed for a term of 3 years.'
