**RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Highway Commission to Make a Study of
the Public Ways of the State.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Highway Commission; authorized to study. Resolved: That in order to make available to the Legislature information on the basis of which it may determine what taxes should be imposed by the State, and in what amounts, in order to assure, insofar as practicable, an equitable distribution of the tax burden among the various classes of persons using Maine's highways or otherwise deriving benefits from such highways, the State Highway Commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to implement, insofar as is necessary, the investigation and study of highways required under Section 210 of the Federal Highway Revenue Act of 1956, so that full information may be available on all public ways in the State; and be it further

Resolved: That the State Highway Commission shall make a final report to the Legislature on the results of the investigation and study required by this resolve as soon as possible, but not later than January 1, 1959.
