SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 546, L. D. 1532, Bill, "An Act Relating  
to Lights on Rear of Trucks."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last 3 underlined paragraphs  
and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'All lights, reflectors and signal lamps required by law to  
be displayed on the rear of all motor vehicles, trailers and semi-  
trailers of 7 feet or over in width shall be at least within 12  
inches of the extreme extension of the rear of such vehicle.'
