## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Rehabilitation and Preservation of Covered Bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 23, § 126-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 126-A, to read as follows:

#### 'Covered Bridges.

- Sec. 126-A. Covered bridges. Upon application by the municipal officers of a municipality responsible for maintenance of a covered wooden bridge on a public highway, the State Highway Commission is authorized to perform such maintenance and rehabilitation work as it considers necessary and practicable for preservation of the structure.'
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 and \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959 to carry out the purposes of this act.
