HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 555, L. D. 1551, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Unfair Sales Act."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 2" of section 1 by striking out all of the 1st sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:

'Any It is hereby declared unlawful for any retailer who, with intent to injure competitors or destroy competition, advertises, effers-te sell-er-sells to advertise, offer to sell or sell at retail any item of merchandise at less than cost to the retailer, or for any whole-saler who, with intent as aforesaid, advertises, effers-te-sell-er sells to advertise, offer to sell or sell at wholesale any item of merchandise at less than cost to the wholesaler shall-be-punished-by a-fine-ef-net-mere-than-\$500.'
