AN ACT Relating to Licensed Dog Training Areas and Permits Therefor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 116, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 116 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No such dog training area shall be of less than ~~100~~ 200 acres, nor of more than 400 acres, nor shall licenses be issued for more than 2 special dog training areas in any one county.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 116, amended. The 4th sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 116 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any person not a licensee may do likewise by making application in writing to licensee and receiving a permit to do so, for which a charge of not to exceed \$1.10 may be made **for residents**, of which amount \$1 shall be paid to the Commissioner and **for nonresidents a charge of not to exceed \$5.10 may be made, of which amount \$5 shall be paid to the Commissioner.**'
