IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Harbor Island in Hancock County to Franklin T. Kurt.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Harbor Island; Forest Commissioner authorized to convey. The Forest Commissioner is hereby authorized to convey all of the right, title and interest of the State of Maine in and to the island lying in Buck Harbor, in that part of the Town of Brooksville called South Brooksville, in the County of Hancock, being designated on the official map of the United States Geological Survey as "Harbor Island" and also known as "Buck's Harbor Island," to Franklin T. Kurt of Huntington, New York, his heirs and assigns forever for the sum of \$1.00; together with adjacent and connected and outlying rocks and reefs to the line of lowest tide on all sides of the same.
