SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1091, L. D. 1585, Bill, "An Act Relating  
to Cutting of Christmas Trees."

Amend said Bill by inserting in the 1st line before the headnote  
'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding thereto a new section to be  
numbered 'Sec. 2.' to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Limitation. The provisions of this act shall not  
apply to landowners who cut and market their own trees.'
