STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide Special Disability Compensation for Members of Police Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 31, § 69, amended. The last paragraph of section 69 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 391 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- '16. Pulmonary and cardiac diseases, excluding common colds.
- 16. Caused to an active member of an organized fire department or police department while participating at fires, and developing within 6 months of such participation; caused to any active member of a police department in the course of duty.
