SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 598, L. D. 1603, Bill, "An Act to
Appropriate Monies for Capital Improvements and Construct-
ion of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June
30, 1958 and June 30, 1959."

Amend said Bill by striking out from the paragraph entitled
"UNIVERSITY OF MAINE" the lines:

	<u>1957-58</u>	<u>1958-59</u>
"Completion of Boardman Hall	---	206,700
Steam Line Extension	---	106,600
University Press	---	<u>196,500</u>
Total Section B	<u>\$1,660,499</u>	<u>\$1,760,833"</u>

and inserting in place thereof, the lines:

'Steam Line Extension	---	52,800
Men's Dormitory	---	<u>457,000</u>
Total Section B	<u>\$1,660,499</u>	<u>\$1,760,833</u>

The University of Maine is authorized to borrow moneys in an amount not to exceed \$616,000 to provide funds to aid in the construction of the Men's Dormitory. Any loans thus made shall not be deemed a pledge of the faith and credit of the State. The authorization to borrow shall expire on July 1, 1959, but any loan may, prior to July 1, 1959, be renewed or extended during a period of 15 years from the date of the original loan.'
