STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase Salaries of Justices of Supreme Judicial Court and Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 103, § 4, amended. The 1st sentence of section 4 of chapter 103 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 472 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court shall each receive an annual salary of \$12,000 \$13,000, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of \$13,000 \$14,000.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 106, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 106 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 472 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 'Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of

\$11,500 \$12,500.'

- Sec. 4. P. L., 1951, c. 403, § 3, repealed. Section 3 of chapter 403 of the public laws of 1951 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 5. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$14,208 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 and \$15,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959, to carry out the purposes of this act.
