IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Arthur O. Payson of Brooks.

Arthur O. Payson; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Arthur O. Payson of Brooks, under the provisions of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, be increased by the amount of \$10 per month.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the time Mr. Payson originally retired in December of 1950 his benefit was figured on the basis of the average salary received by him during his last 5 years of service. This method of computing his benefit developed a monthly pension of substantially less than he would have received had the benefit been figured on the basis of his average salary for the 5 years during which it was the highest. The purpose of this resolve is to adjust, to some extent at least, this inequity.

Due to Mr. Payson's advanced age, the total cost to the State will not exceed approximately \$670.
