## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 98th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1116, L.D. 1632, Bill, "An Act Relating to Municipal Zoning Boards of Appeal."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the blocked paragraph and inserting thereof a new subparagraph 1A to read as follows:

"Municipalities of 5000 or more inhabitants may by ordinance provide for a board of appeals consisting of 5 or 7 members and one associate member. The terms of office of members shall not exceed 5 years and initial appointments shall be such that the terms of office of no more than 2 members shall expire in any single year."
