IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT

AN ACT Permitting Town of Madawaska to Raise Money for Nursing Home.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Madawaska to raise money for nursing home. The Town of Madawaska, Aroostook County, may raise or appropriate money to provide for or support a nursing home for the hospitalization or nursing care of aged human beings.

SUMMARY STATEMENT

There is presently no provision of law permitting municipalities to raise money for nursing homes.

This bill will permit only the Town of Madawaska to raise money for this purpose to alleviate a serious lack of nursing home care for aged persons.
