STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Set Off Part of Town of Benedicta to Town of Sherman.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Part of Town of Benedicta set off. All of Lot No. 30, as designated on Rae and Colby Plan dated 1877, in the Town of Benedicta, Aroostook County, shall be and hereby is set off from the Town of Benedicta and annexed to the Town of Sherman in Aroostook County.

SUMMARY STATEMENT

Selectmen of both Benedicta and Sherman will present assents to this bill. Because of the constitutional prohibition against emergency measures involving the right of home-rule, no emergency enactor is contained in this measure. This same constitutional prohibition, however, would prevent the January 1959 session from passing the bill so that the transfer could be effective on April 1, 1959; thus it appears essential that the bill be considered at this special session without an emergency enactor if it is to be effective prior to the April 1, 1959 tax assessment date.
