STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT

AN ACT Reimbursing Municipalities for Travel by Police Officers and Constables in Criminal Processes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 146, § 2-A, sub-§ IV, amended. Subsection IV of section 2-A of chapter 146 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 10 of chapter 334 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by inserting after the 2nd paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

'Municipalities shall be reimbursed by the county for all reasonable expenses incurred by police officers and constables for travel within the State between their employing municipality and any other place within the State when such travel is for the purpose of making an arrest on a criminal warrant or to commit a person to any jail or institution within the State.'
