AN ACT Increasing Payments to Androscoggin County Law Library.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the establishment and maintenance of county law libraries are essential to the preservation of the rights and liberties of the people; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to permit the trustees of the Androscoggin County Law Library to carry out their duties as established by law; and

Whereas, county funds are available to permit the trustees of the Androscoggin County Law Library to carry out their duties; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 135, amended. That part of section 135 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes which relates to the Androscoggin County Law Library, as amended by chapter 93 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin, ~~\$2,750~~ \$3,500.'

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
