STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT

AN ACT Relating to Loans to Minors for Higher Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 119, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 119 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that any minor sixteen years of age or over, who receives aid and assistance from the New England Higher Education Assistance Foundation for the purpose of furthering his higher education in professional, technical, scientific or literary fields in the form of a loan or loans made or guaranteed in full or in part by said Foundation, shall have full legal capacity for such purpose to act in his own behalf in the matter of notes, contracts, and other transactions, and with respect to such acts done by him, he shall have rights, powers and privileges and be subject to the obligations of persons of full age.'
