STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Butter and Margarine Under Weights and Measures Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32-A, § 33, amended. Section 33 of chapter 32-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 260 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 33. Butter, oleomargarine and margarine. Butter, oleomargarine and margarine shall be offered and exposed for sale and sold by weight, and ~~when in package form these commodities shall be packaged~~ only in units of $\frac{1}{4}$ pound, $\frac{1}{2}$ pound, one pound or multiples of one pound, avoirdupois weight.'
