STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Payments to County Law Library at Rumford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1917, c. 88, amended. Chapter 88 of the private and special laws of 1917, as last amended by chapter 56 of the private and special laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'County to contribute to support of county law library at Rumford. The treasurer of Oxford County shall annually pay to the treasurer of the Law Library Association of said county for the uses and benefits of the county law library at Rumford the sum of \$\frac{\pma}{2},759\$ \$2,250; this sum being additional to the amount provided by law for the use of the county law library at Paris in said county.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1959.
