AN ACT Relating to Definition of Liquor Under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 1, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 1 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, which defines "Liquor," is amended to read as follows:

' "Liquor" shall mean and include any alcoholic, spirituous, vinous, fermented or other alcoholic beverage, or combination of liquors and mixed liquors, intended for human consumption, which contains more than ~~1%~~ $\frac{1}{2}\%$ of alcohol by volume.'
