STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Oakfield for Aid to Family of Leo Cote.

Town of Oakfield; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$3,251.25 to be paid to the Town of Oakfield to reimburse it for aid given to family of Leo Cote.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1952 the Town of Oakfield began to support the family of Leo Cote who at the time was living in Augusta. In December, 1957, the town furnished its last aid and at that time the State of Maine started to pay. This resolve is to reimburse the Town of Oakfield for the aid given between 1952 and 1957. The State of Maine in 1945 declared Mr. Cote to be non-settled but did not assume responsibility until 1957.

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
