
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to State Aid for School Construction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 237-H, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 237-H of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Said apportionment shall apply similarly to payments made for capital outlay purposes on school construction approved by the Commissioner of Education after August 28, 1957, in single municipality administrative units where the April 1st enrollment of resident pupils in grades 9 through 12 for that year is over **700 300** pupils and in smaller administrative units when in the judgment of the Legislature, on recommendation of the commission, the formation of a School Administrative District by consolidation is not geographically or educationally practical.'



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
